Scholarship Criteria

An applicant for the scholarship must:

1. Be a junior, senior, or graduate level, full-time college student. (A sophomore may apply if the award is to be made at the start of the junior year.)
2. Have a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale on all college work undertaken.
3. Have completed 9 hours of accounting (principles of accounting can count toward the 9 hours).
4. Be either (a) a permanent resident of the area served by the East Texas Chapter TSCPA or (b) attend, or plan to attend during the scholarship period, a college in the East Texas Chapter area. The East Texas Chapter area is composed of the following 20 counties: Anderson, Angelina, Cherokee, Freestone, Gregg, Harrison, Henderson, Houston, Marion, Nacogdoches, Panola, Rains, Rusk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, Smith, Upshur, Van Zandt, and Wood.
5. Be a declared accounting major.
6. The scholarship **MAY** be renewed for a maximum of one (1) year. Re-application is required.

The award shall be for a period of one academic year, payable one half each semester. The recipient will need only to provide evidence of continued qualification for the second semester award. Scholarship payments are mailed directly to financial institution recipient is attending.

The recipient of the award may apply for succeeding awards as long as the criteria are met.

Winners will be selected on the basis of grade history and the ability to make a contribution to the accounting profession. The judgment of the selection committee will be final.

A full-time undergraduate student is one who is enrolled for 12 or more semester hours credit in one semester; a graduate student, 6 or more semester hours. A junior is a student having 60 or more semester hours credit.

Completed applications should be either mailed to the address below or emailed to etctscpa@tyler.net and should be received by the East Texas Chapter of the Texas Society of CPAs no later than March 10, 2017. Letters of recommendations may be sent separately by the recommender but must be received by the deadline. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.
